A. <u>HELDERBERG HIGH SCHOOL FEES</u>

1. APPLICATION FEE

Each new application for admission must be accompanied by a non-refundable fee of R700.00. Applications close on 31 October.

A late application fee of R200.00 will be charged thereafter.

2. REGISTRATION DEPOSIT

A registration deposit of R2 000.00 is payable upon acceptance of a learner.

This non-interest-bearing deposit will be refunded when the learner matriculates at Helderberg High School.

3. TUITION FEES - 2026

ALL FEES ARE PAYABLE IN ADVANCE.

- The first payment is due on or before the first day of school (preferably in December).

 Subsequent payments are due at the end of each month for the following month (e.g. end January for February, end February for March payment etc.).
- Tuition fees **EXCLUDE** school uniforms, textbooks, and stationery. Please budget for these additional expenses.
- Annual laboratory fees (Art, Computer, Physical Science, Consumer Studies and Life Science) are included in the tuition fee.

B. PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES

- 1. Tuition fees are payable to Helderberg High School.
- 2. Tuition Fees may be paid monthly, quarterly, half-yearly or annually in advance.

- **3.** Interest is charged on overdue accounts at 2% per month.
