SUMMER UNIFORM (Term 1 – end April 1 Oct – Term 4)	GIRLS	BOYS
Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Short-sleeve with school name No coloured shirts to be worn underneath white school shirt 	
Pants/skirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grey school panelled skirt Preferably knee length (not shorter than 7cm from top of knee cap and 10cm from knee crease at the back) Matrics may wear a black skirt/long pants (no jeans) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grey shorts or long pants Matrics may wear black long pants (no jeans)
Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Short white socks (no other colour or pattern on them) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Long grey socks (no other colour or pattern on them)
Jersey / Blazer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Long sleeve or short sleeve school jersey Navy blazer with badge No rain jackets should be worn Matrics to wear their matric jacket 	

WINTER UNIFORM (1 May – 1 Oct)	GIRLS	BOYS
Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Long-sleeve white button-up shirt Tie must be worn No coloured shirts to be worn underneath white school shirt 	
Pants/skirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grey school panelled skirt Preferably knee length (not shorter than 7cm from top of knee cap and 10cm from knee crease at the back) OR Grey school long pants Matrics may wear a black skirt/long pants (no jeans) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grey long pants Matrics may wear a black long pants (no jeans)
Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> White/grey/black socks with long pants Black stockings with skirt No socks should be visible beneath stockings 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Long grey socks (no other colour or pattern on them) Matrics may wear grey or black socks
Jersey / Blazer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Long sleeve or short sleeve school jersey Navy blazer with badge Rain jackets may be worn only if it is raining Matrics to wear their matric jacket 	
Scarf	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A plain, navy blue or black scarf may be worn (as indicated in General Rules) Any other coloured/patterned scarves will be confiscated without warning 	

OTHER UNIFORM (Whole year)	GIRLS	BOYS
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only black school shoes that can be polished may be worn • No tekkies or pumps are allowed • Matrics are not exempted from this rule 	
Jewellery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No jewellery at school • This includes earrings, rings, nose rings, belly rings, bangles, bits of string/leather • No plasters covering piercings will be allowed, have piercing done during the holidays. • Plastic posts are allowed, but should be clear plastic and hardly visible. 	
Hair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Long hair should be tied up away from the face • Only hairbands and accessories in school colours may be worn • Hair may be dyed natural colours, but non-natural hair colour is not allowed • No shaven undercuts allowed • The same rules count for any hair extensions worn, no bling allowed in weaves. • Matric girls must have their hair tied away from their face 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hair should be kept short • No gelling back of long hair is allowed • No lines may be shaven in hair • Hair may be dyed natural colours, but non-natural hair colour is not allowed • No shaven undercuts allowed • Hair may not be braided
Beard		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Boys should be clean shaven
Nails	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nails should be kept short • No nail polish is allowed • Matric girls may wear French nails or natural nail polish, but nails must be kept short • No gel nails allowed (included matric girls) 	
Blanket	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A blanket may be used to keep warm in classes, but must be either plain blue, black or grey. Any other colour will be confiscated without warning 	
Gloves / Beanies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gloves may be worn if they are plain black, blue or grey • Beanies are not school uniform and will be confiscated without warning 	
Assembly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rain jackets may not be worn in assembly, only blazers (compulsory on Mondays) • Matrics must wear their matric jackets when they have received them, otherwise they should wear their blazer 	
Civvies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No revealing necklines, short shorts or short skirts • No offensive imagery or slogans • Rules for <u>jewellery</u>, <u>hair</u> and <u>nails</u> still apply 	

Procedure:

- If you cannot wear school uniform you must go to your register teacher and get the **INCORRECT UNIFORM** form signed by him/her.
- Without this form you will be put on **detention** for incorrect uniform (without exception).
